

## NOTICE

The competent authority of the University has approved the "Publication-Honorarium Policy for the students" of The Neotia University (TNU).

You are advised to go through the combinations that may be practiced while considering honorarium for the students publishing an article in favour of TNU.

- 1. The applicant should be a regular student of TNU.
- 2. The student should be a corresponding author/first author of the publication.
- 3. The student acknowledges the affiliation of TNU in the publication clearly.

## Publication in category 1

- 1. The article should be published in a national or international peer-reviewed journal.
- The article must be a comprehensive research or review article or case study or short communication or letter to the editor.
- 3. The article should be published in a UGC-CARE approved journal.
- 4. The article should be indexed by SCI or Scopus or equivalent body.
- 5. The article published in the journal must have an impact factor proposed by a journal based on RG or Science Citation Index (SCI).

The student publishing article by fulfilling all the above mentioned criteria category 1 may be supported by giving an honorarium of rupees 5000 against each publication.

## Publication in category 2

- 1. The article should be published in a national or international peer-reviewed journal.
- The article must be a comprehensive research or review article or case study or study or short communication or letter to the editor.
- The article should be published in a UGC-CARE approved journal or Regulatory body endorsed journal (approved by TNU)

The student publishing article by fulfilling all the above mentioned criteria of category 2 may be supported by giving an honorarium of rupees 2000 against each publication.

The concerned student may approach the R&D committee of TNU for honorarium with a pdf of the publication adhering to the above mentioned category (either category 1 or category 2) completely .The R&D committee shall express their observation in this regard and shall send all the relevant documents to the Hon'ble Pro-Chancellor for the final approval.

P.S: Please note that publication of students after 01.02.2022 shall be considered for funding provided the publication satisfies all the eligibility criteria.
